**273-1. OATH**

Before commencing the business of the Board, the PCB administered oath of allegiance to the constitution of India to Smt. Bina Nautiyal as the Member of the Board under section 17 of the Cantonments Act, 2006.

**273-1. RESOLUTION**

The Board noted the oath taking of Smt. Bina Nautiyal having become the Member of the Cantonment Board, Clement Town.

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**274-2. RESOLUTION**

The Board considered and approved the Residential Building Plans from Sr. No. 2 to 25 and Addition / Alteration building plans from Sr. No. 1 to 7.

In respect of Sr. No. 1 of Residential Building Plan i.e. Smt. Suman Chhetri, the Board resolved that as the land is situated within 10 metres of A1 Defence Land, the site will be inspected by the Adm. Comdt. Stn. HQrs Clement Town and the matter will be placed in the next Board meeting. A joint survey can be held to check the residential plan on the site in consultation with Stn. HQrs., Clement Town.

In respect of Commercial Building Plan, the Board resolved that a minimum 20 feet space should be left for road parking on main Turner Road Side. Further, the Board resolved that the plan be returned to the applicant for necessary amendment.

**275-3. DISPOSAL OF DANGEROUS TREES**

Reference CBR No. 268-29 dated 7.9.2021.

Vide above referred CBR the Cantt Board has resolved that the dangerous trees situated in Cantt Junior High School may be disposed off by public auction. Accordingly the Cantt Board has prepared the MRP of above said dangerous trees. As calculated by the technical staff of Cant Board the MRP of the dangerous trees is Rs. 54000/-. In this regard, it is also to intimate that the rates has been calculated on the basis of Uttarakhand State, Shiwalik Range Rate list dated 15.06.2012 and the inflation of 10 years has also been considered. **276-4. INCREASE OF STREET LIGHT POINTS IN CANTT AREA**

It is submitted that at present the Cantt Board is maintaining 650 street light points in civil area of Cantt. As the civil population of the Cantt is increasing day by day and new colonies have developed it is proposed to increase 150 street lights point in Cantt area.

The matter is placed for the consideration and approval of the Board.

**276-4. RESOLUTION**

The Board discussed that with the revised development charges, Board will be in position to increase additional 150 street lights which is imperative for security. The Board considered and approved the proposal and authorized the CEO to take necessary action in this regard.

**278-6. RESOLUTION**

The Board considered and discussed the matter in detail and resolved that the Uttarakhand Pey Jal Sansadhan Vikas Avam Nirman Nigam be asked to make a detailed presentation before the Board so that further action may be taken up in this regard.

**279-7. SPECIAL CAMPAIGN FROM 2<sup>ND</sup> TO 31<sup>ST</sup> OCT 2021 FOR THE CLEANLINESS AND DISPOSE SCRAP**

To consider GoI Mod New Delhi letter No 76/68/ Swachh Bharat /C/DE/2021 dated 18.10.2021 regarding direction for undertaking Cleanliness drive and dispose scrap from the Cantt fund buildings during 2<sup>nd</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 2021. The Cantt fund properties may be visited by the officers of the Dte or DGDE office. In this regard it is to intimate that as per the directions the Cantt Board has taken following initiatives:

- (i) Cantt Board office has prepared a list of scraps items, like Old doors and windows, old iron railing and grills, Unserviceable street lights fixtures etc, stored in the Cantt office. The MRP of the items as calculated by the Cantt office is only Rs 20,000/-. The Cantt Board has already given advertisement in the News paper for the public auction of the scrap. The public auction is to be conducted on 23.10.2021. The matter is placed for the ratification of the action taken by the CEO Cantt Board Clement Town.
- (ii) It is proposed to auction the fire wood stored in the Cantt Office and hospital compound. The MRP of the wood is Rs 2400/ only hence no news paper ad

has been given. The auction is proposed to be held on 25.10.2021. The matter is placed for the ratification of the action taken by the CEO Cantt Board Clement Town.

- (iii) It is proposed to paint the external walls of Cantt Office with Weather proof Acrylic Paint (Apex) as the walls were painted during 2017-18 and now in a very shabby state. . The approximate cost of work is Rs 1.20 Lac only. Matter is placed for the approval of estimate.

Considered and approved. The Board authorized the CEO to take appropriate action as mentioned in para (i) and (ii) and incur the necessary expenditure as per para (iii).

**280-8. RESOLUTION**

Considered and approved. The Board resolved that all the properties mentioned from Sr. No. 1 to 20 in the agenda be mutated in favor of transferee under Section 81 of the Cantonments Act, 2006. This mutation is not a proof of ownership of property. This is done only for recovery of taxes. The records of the Board be amended accordingly. Also, Board directed that the documents be rechecked before finally mutating the properties in the name of transferees.

**281-9. GRANT OF ENHANCED DEARNESS RELIEF TO CANTT BOARD PENSIONERS @28%**

To consider and approve grant of enhanced DR to the pensioners of Cantt Board, Clement Town from existing 17% to 28% w.e.f 01.07.2021 as granted by the Govt. of Uttarakhand G.O. No. 220/XXVII(7)02/2016 dated 24.09.2021 to their pensioners. The Cantonment Board pensioners are also eligible to get the said enhanced rate of DR on the same term & condition as per Clause 14(1) of Memorandum of Settlement arrived at between Cantonment Board and their workman on 31.05.1969.

The financial implication for payment of above DR would be Rs.1,75,000/- per month. The Budget Provision exist.

**281-9. RESOLUTION**

Considered and approved. Necessary proposal be sent to the PDDE, Central Command, Lucknow for sanction.

**282-10. GRANT OF ENHANCED DA TO CANTT BOARD EMPLOYEES @28%**

To consider and approve grant of enhanced DA to the employees of Cantt Board, Clement Town from existing 17% to 28% w.e.f 01.07.2021 as granted by the Govt. of Uttarakhand G.O. No. 219/XXVII(7)02/2016 dated 24.09.2021 to their employees. The Cantonment Board employees are also eligible to get the said enhanced rate of DA on the same term & condition as per Clause 14(1) of Memorandum of Settlement arrived at between Cantonment Board and their workman on 31.05.1969.

The Sanctioned received from Principal Director, Defence Estates letter No. 9334/Uttarakhand/DA/LCP/III dated 07.10.2021.

The financial implication for payment of above DA would be Rs.4,13,983/- per month. The Budget Provision exist.

The Board noted and approved for implementing the Dearness Allowance from @17% to 28% w.e.f 01.07.2021.

**282-10. RESOLUTION**

Noted and approved. The Board authorized the CEO to incur the necessary expenditure for payment of arrears of DA to Cantt. Fund employees as per sanction of the PDDE, CC, Lucknow.

**283-11. DIRECTORATE LETTER NO. 34238/C'TOWN/SI/16(C-527) DATED 21.05.2018**

To read and consider application of Shri Rajendra Prasad Chamoli, Ex-Sanitary Inspector dated 18.03.2019, 06.04.2021 Uttarakhand G.O. No. 872/XXVII(7) नमस्ति / 2011 dated 08.03.2011 and Uttarakhand G.O. No. 589/XXVII(7)40(IX)/2011 dated 01.07.2013. It has been revealed that the employees of Cantonment Board, Clement Town are also

5. II<sup>nd</sup> ACP is due since on 01.09.2008 in Pay Scale 9300 - 34800 + G.P. 4600
6. III<sup>rd</sup> MACP is due from 18.07.2017 in the Pay Scale of 9300 - 34800 + G.P. 4800 after continuous 10 years satisfactory service on grant of II<sup>nd</sup> ACP.

To, consider and approve a bill of lease line connectivity against customer Id No. 7000277830 and A/C 7000278292 has received in this office from DGDE BSNL for the payment of Rs. 2,37,621/- out of which Rs.1,58,668/- has already been paid on dated 18.03.2021, remaining amount of Rs.78,954/- has to be paid.

Bill is put up before the Board for consideration and payment of Rs.78,954/- to avoid the disconnection by the BSNL. The Budget provision exist for 2021-22 (R).

The lease line bill is placed on the table for approval

In this regard, one tractor hydraulic trolley size 10 X 6 X 4 feet is required for carrying the garbage from area. The approximate cost of the aforesaid hydraulic trolley is Rs. 3,25,000/- with approximate carrying capacity 06 ton.
